



UX/UI Design and Development for Betagro Lunch Community Application and Livestock Contract Payment System (LCPS) Phase 2

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ABSTRACT

This project applies a user-centered UX/UI design approach to improve internal systems at Betagro Public Company Limited. It focuses on enhancing operational efficiency and user experience.

The Betagro Lunch Community Application was developed to address issues identified through user interviews, including limited meal options and long waiting times. The high-fidelity prototype achieved over 90% task completion rate and reduced ordering time by approximately 40–50%.

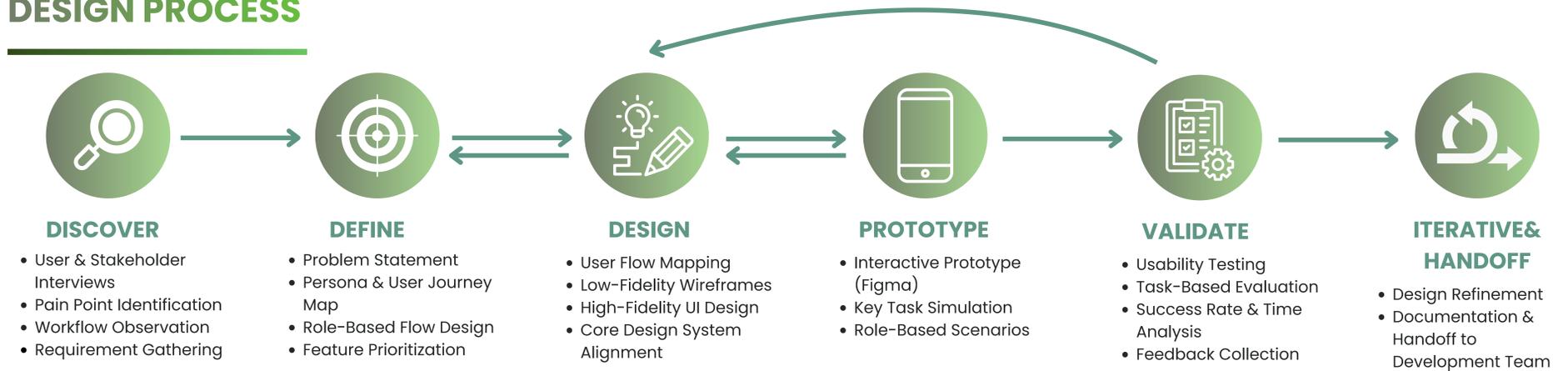
The Livestock Contract Payment System (LCPS) Phase 2 extends existing features by integrating workflow analysis, real-time calculations, and E-Sign functionality. Both projects were validated through usability testing before handover for development.

Large organizations rely on internal digital systems to support operational workflows; however, inefficiencies often occur when system design does not align with actual user behavior and practical business needs.

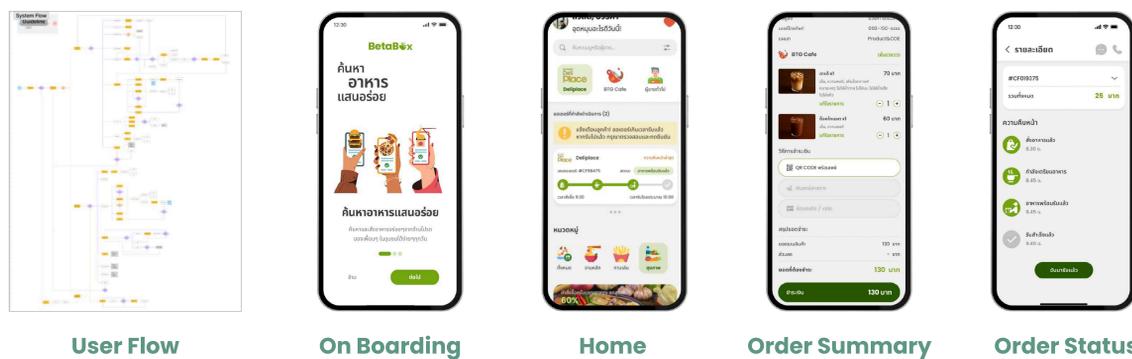
At Betagro Public Company Limited, employees experienced limited meal options and long waiting times during lunch breaks, while the livestock payment system required expansion from swine to poultry sectors. To address these challenges, this study applied the Design Thinking methodology to transform interview insights into validated digital solutions, introducing real-time calculations and E-Sign functionality to reduce manual errors, streamline processes, and improve overall operational efficiency within the organization.

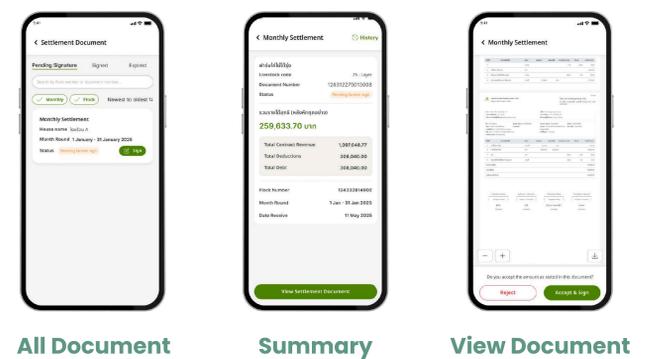
